The second case involved a patient who died of drowning. The third case involved a 2-year-old who was taking both atomoxetine and olanzapine at high doses at the time of her death. The forth concerned a 5-year-old male who died during a school activity, possibly due to an asthma attack. Though the HCP reporters in the last 2 fatal cases commented that the events were unlikely associated to atomoxetine, based on the information provided, the role of atomoxetine in these 2 cases could be neither confirmed nor ruled out.
